



The Vision What is LTDH:EDU?





Imagine an event where the complex world of cybersecurity becomes a thrilling adventure, a place where high school students don't just learn about technology, but live it. Solving mysteries, cracking codes, and building the web.

That's Le Tour Du Hack: Education Edition (LTDH:EDU).

We are creating a one-of-a-kind, full-day conference designed to ignite a passion for technology in S3-S6 students and to empower the educators who guide them. In a world where cyber skills are more critical than ever, our mission is to demystify the field, showcase its incredible creative potential, and inspire the next generation of digital defenders, creators, and innovators.





The Day What Are We Planning?

LTDH:EDU is a dual-stream event, offering a rich, immersive experience for **both students and their teachers**, running in parallel throughout the day. We're planning a full-day format, potentially held over a weekend to host a different cohort of students each day.

For Students



Students will select one of four incredible, full-day workshop tracks.

Each track is a deep dive into a different area of cybersecurity, designed as a hands-on, project-based experience where they learn by doing.

From the moment they arrive, they'll be part of a team, working together to solve challenges and create something amazing.

The Details

Students are required to bring a packed lunch.

Refreshments and snacks will be provided throughout the day.

For Educators



While students are on their adventures, some educators will have their own dedicated conference.

This stream is designed to provide practical tools, share new teaching methods, and build a strong community of educators passionate about technology.

They'll leave with fresh ideas and the resources needed to bring cybersecurity education to life in their own classrooms.






